Directions to 6R Laurel Road from Northampton

Take Route 9 West from Northampton, continuing through the town of Florence.
Continue on Route 9 through Leeds to the Village of Haydenville (in the town of Williamsburg.)

In the center of town, just before the white Congregational Church, take a right onto High Street. Continue approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ mile and turn right onto Laurel Road. At top of hill, (approx. 1/10 mi.) turn right into 6R Laurel Road. Drive around loop and park facing out.

In the event of rain, lunch will be served at the Williamsburg Senior Center, which is located next to the Congregational Church. Parking is behind the Senior Center, accessed behind the church.
