Dear Hilltown neighbor,

We want to help make buying food at a local corner grocery store or farm stand easier to afford for Hilltown residents experiencing economic stress due to the COVID 19 pandemic.

We also want to support local food retailers in a difficult time and are impressed by their commitment to the safety of their customers by offering curbside pickup or a less crowded shopping experience than the large chain grocery stores.

But we know that small retailers can't match the prices of the large grocery chains -so we have created a short-term **Hilltown Food Bucks** program to help seniors and low-moderate income families stretch their food-buying dollars.

For up to five months (program ends **May 31, 2021**) program participants will be mailed Hilltown Food Bucks coupons which they can redeem at the retailers listed below for discounts - *\$5 off each \$10 worth of purchases.* If you spend \$80 at a store or farm stand, you can use \$40 worth of coupons and pay \$40 from your own food budget, for example. Each eligible individual or family **will receive \$100 - \$125 worth** of Hilltown Food Bucks a month depending on household size.

Program funding is limited, and will fill on a first come, first serve basis – we will let you know if a slot is available for you after we receive your application. In addition, at this time we are ONLY able to include residents of the towns authorized for Community Development Block Grant funds: Ashfield, Blandford, Chester, Chesterfield, Cummington, Goshen, Huntington, Middlefield, Montgomery, Plainfield, Williamsburg and Worthington.
